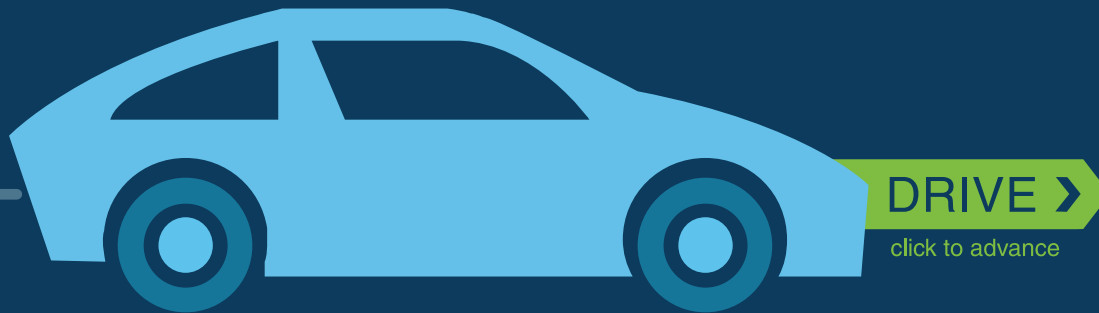
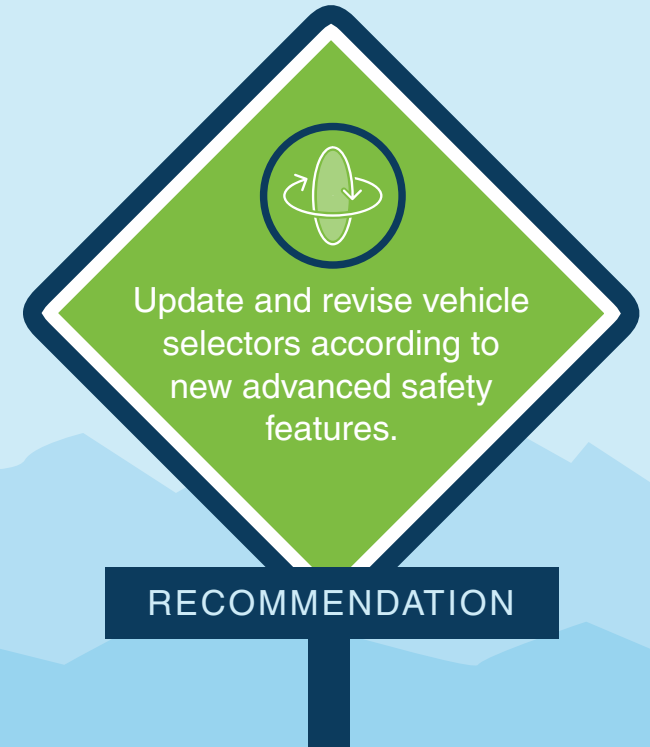
A 2019 study found lower crash rates as a result of crash-avoidance technologies.¹

Key Facts:

Forward collision warning plus autobrake:
56%↓
in front-to-rear crashes with injuries

Rear Automatic Braking:
78%↓
in backing crashes (when combined with rearview camera and parking sensors)

50,000 crashes and almost **16,000 injuries** could have been prevented if every U.S. vehicle in 2015 were equipped with blind spot monitoring²

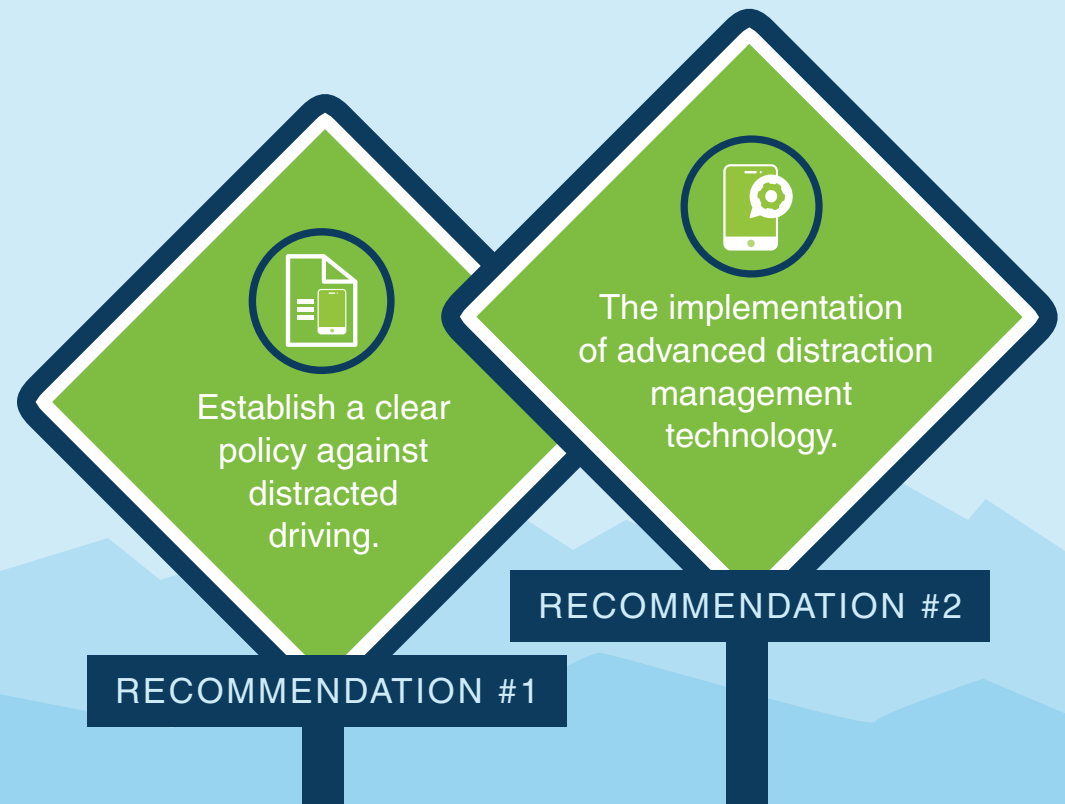

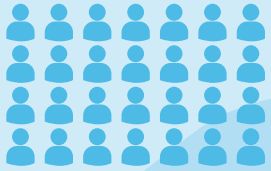
